

DEUEL COUNTY LAKES AND STREAMS

September 13, 2011

Mel's Diner, Clear Lake SD

President Dan Ashbaugh called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM, Elois Redlin read the minutes from the last meeting, and Ethel Troska gave the treasurer's report. There is one correction on the minutes from the August meeting; the donation for the museum was paid from both the Clear Lake Restoration and the Deuel County Lakes & Streams, \$50.00 each for a total of \$100.00. Pete Dumke made a motion seconded by LeRoy Stohr to approve the reports with the correction noted. Motion carried.

LeRoy Stohr reported on the tickets for the fishing trip raffle. The drawing will be held live on air during the KWAT What's Up show as soon as all the tickets are sold. The drawing will be for one trip for two participants. Tickets are now available from any DCLS member at a price of \$20.00 each. The fishing trip involves three days and two nights for two people at Outrages Adventures located at Mobridge SD. The winner will be able to plan the trip to fit their own schedule, and Kerry Konold will be the host and guide on the fishing excursion.

The football books have all been sold and the first games were September 12, and the last game will be December 26.

Jim Dailey reported on the need for an outlet on Lake Alice because the lake is over-full, causing shoreline erosion. Elois Redlin reviewed the history of the outlet project which was part of the watershed project sponsored by Deuel Conservation District. The outlet was not constructed at that time due to project budget and time-line constraints. Ernie Schake moved seconded by Gordon Anderson to send a letter of support to state officials to have an outlet installed on the lake. Motion carried.

Dennis Norton reported on the cost of two new aerator motors. The purchase of two new motors was approved at the August meeting, so Dennis will proceed with the purchase.

Rita Ashbaugh moved seconded by Pete Dumke to authorize the expenditure for repairs to fix the other motors that need them. Motion carried.

A bill from Clear Lake Courier was presented for printing the football books and the raffle tickets in the amount of \$286.20. Dave Bartling moved seconded by Gordon Anderson to pay the bill, motion carried.
